

COMMUNITY CUP SCHEME GUIDANCE

Reusing will reduce waste and litter. Why not use a Deposit Return Cup Scheme at your event? Litter Free Dorset have 1000+ community cups which can be borrowed for community events



WHAT'S INVOLVED

- ✓ Customers buy a community cup for a £2 deposit
- ✓ When people are done with their drink they can return the cup for their deposit back
- ✓ Cups will be washed and packed away for next event



HOW THE PROCESS WORKS

- 1 Contact Litter Free Dorset to book your cups
- 2 Collect from Litter Free Dorset and sign cup agreement
- 3 Customers buy a community cup for a £2 deposit with their drink
- 4 Used cups collected back from bar or collection point and £2 deposit is returned
- 5 After the event: Count the remaining cups and figure out losses, which you pay back to LFD using deposit money
- 6 Please wash, dry and pack up cups for return
- 7 Cups are returned to Litter Free Dorset



TOP TIPS FOR ORGANISERS

- ✓ Speak to a local cafe, pub or hotel and see if they will support you event by washing cups
- ✓ Give customers the option to receive their deposit back or donate it to your event or a local charity
- ✓ To encourage maximum return of cups after the event, have cup drop points near exits and display signage about returning
